

ISEO is going to appoint Roberto Gaspari as Chief Executive Officer.

In 2018, the ISEO Group turnover was € 138 million - with approximately three quarters of the revenue generated on international markets - and the Gross Operating Margin over € 14 million. The group, based in Pisogne (Brescia), operates with 3 plants in Italy, as well as production sites in Romania, France, Germany and Spain.
